

Minutes of the Special Selectboard Meeting
Monday, September 5, 2011, 6:00 PM, Crossett Brook Middle School

All Selectboard members were in attendance. 45 residents were in attendance.
The Chair called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

1. On a motion by Ames Robb, seconded by Joann Berno, the Board unanimously agreed to appoint Bob Magee as the Town's Emergency Management Coordinator.
2. Dick Charland reported on the status of Camels Hump Road and Bridge. There is a concern in finding a contractor to erect the temporary bridge. VTrans reported that the bridge abutment has cracked and settled.

On a motion by Craig Isvak, seconded by Ames Robb, the Board voted unanimously to purchase a temporary bridge from the A company for cost of \$170,000.00.

3. The Chair called upon Ed Patterson to give a report on conditions in Patterson Park and on Main Street in general. 29 residences were affected by flooding. There is a concern with health hazards related to water quality and fuel which leaked into the water and then into the ground. FEMA is to visit the area on Friday, September 9th. Mr. Patterson expressed his gratitude to all who volunteered to help clean up the Park.
4. Ruth Haskins, Director of the Duxbury Food Shelf, shared her concern with the mold/mildew problem in the stairway of the Town Office. The Food Shelf lost about \$1,000 in food and commodities due to the electricity being out for a few days. Everything is now back to normal at the Food Shelf.
5. Sherry Welch reported that the Duxbury Historical Society has started a recovery relief project at the Town Garage. Clothing and food is being collected. To date approximately 615 lunches and 118 suppers have been provided.
6. Central Vermont Community Action workers were present at the meeting to assist those impacted by the storm flooding.

On a motion by Joann Berno, seconded by Craig Isvak, the Meeting was adjourned at 8:05 PM.
